# OUTBOUND

## Everything You Need to Know

Outbound is an outdoor program from Healdsburg Community Church designed with spiritual formation in mind. The goal of Outbound is to provide youth in the Healdsburg community with opportunities to better connect with themselves, each other, and with God, all via engagement with the outdoors.

## How it Works

### CONNECTION WITH GOD IN NATURE

Each month, the Outbound team will embark on an outdoor adventure specifically designed to teach them something new about God.

### CONNECTION WITH SELF

Following each experience, students will be sent home with a booklet containing Scripture passages and questions to allow each student to reflect on what they may have learned about themselves and their relationship with God through their experience.

### CONNECTION WITH OTHERS

Then, students will come together for what's known as "Basecamp": a socially distanced gathering outside where the team will discuss their experience, what they learned, and prepare for the next month's adventure.

### CAPSTONE

At the end of each year, Outbound will come to its completion in a capstone experience, where students will apply skills they have learned over the course of the year to embark on a backpacking adventure.

To participate in the capstone event, students will need to have attended at least 5 of the outdoor adventures, and 10 basecamp meetings.

### COST

\$250 will be collected from each student at the beginning of the semester to cover the costs of that semester's events, the take-home materials, and the capstone event.
